POINT VALUES WILL NOW BE AS FOLLOWS: ONE POINT WILL BE RECEIVED FOR THE FIRST FORTY CHALLENGES AND FORTY MUST BE GAINED TO RECEIVE THE INITIAL POINT. FROM THEN ON, 1/4 POINT WILL BE RECEIVED FOR E.CH SUBSEQUENT 10 POINTS.

ARE YOU TAKING A PARROT HOME?

GOING THROUGH MEXICO CITY?

THE 12 NOON PERFORMANCE OF THE BALLET FOLKLORICO IS BEST BET FOR GOOD SEATS.

ELDERS LESVING IN GROUPS HEADING FOR THE SAME STATE DESTINATION WILL DO WELL IN WEIGHING LUGGIGE IN AT THE AIRPORT AS A GROUP AS THE CHINCES ARE BETTER IN NOT HAVING TO PAY OVERWEIGHT CHARGES.

IF YOU ARE IN SALVADOR WHEN YOUR MISSION ENDS, MAKE SURE YOU CHECK INTO THE OFFICE E.RLY THE DAY YOU GO HOME BECAUSE YOUR PASSPORTS ARE REQUIRED TO PICK UP YOUR PLANE TICKET. THIS IS FOR ANYBODY, WHETHER YOU ARE GOING THROUGH MEXICO OR NOT.

KING MIDAS SOUGHT IT, SOLOMON HAD IT, AND HERRERA SEEMS TO BE GETTING IT, THAT IS, MONEY.

INJURIES TO ELDERS ANNUALLY COST THIS MISSION A TREMENDOUS AMOUNT OF MONEY, A SUM FOR WHICH THE MISSION SHOULD NOT BE RESPON-SIBLE. ALMOST EVERY ELDER BEFORE COMING ON HIS MISSION BOUGHT INSURANCE THAT INSURES HIM AGAINST ACCIDENT, INJURY, HOSPITALIZ-ATION ETC. MOST PARENTS HAVE SEPARATE INSURANCE POLICIES THAT ALSO PROTECT THEIR MISSIONARY DURING HIS MISSION.

IT IS NOT VERY GOOD BUSINESS NOR SENSE TO PAY FOR SOMETHING THAT YOU DON'T HAVE TO PAY FOR, YET MANY MISSIONARIES PAY AS HIGH AS FORTY DOLLARS AND THE CHURCH MUCH MORE WHEN FOR A FEW MINUTES OF LETTER WRITING THE MISSIONARY COULD SAVE HIMSELF AND THE CHURCH MONEY AND PROBLEMS.

IF YOU FIND THE LANGUAGE IN THE POLICIES A LITTLE HARD TO UNDERSTAND BE RECONCILED IN THE F.CT. THIT THEY ARE DESIGNED SO THAT ANY SIMPLE-MINDED PERSON CAN UNDERST NO THEM, THEREFORE YOUR COMPANION OR DISTRICT LEADER WILL BE OF GREAT HELP IN THE MATTER.

FROM THE LAND OF THE "GUANACOS"
